

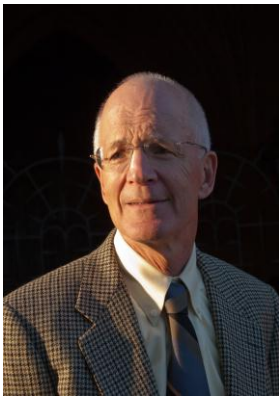

Edward L. Cussler, currently Distinguished Institute Professor at the University of Minnesota, obtained his B.E. from Yale University in 1961, and his M.S. and Ph.D. from the University of Wisconsin. After thirteen years at Carnegie-Mellon University, Cussler American Institute of Chemical Engineers, for whom he served as President. He has received the Separations Science Award from the American Chemical Society, the Merryfield Design Award from the American Society of Engineering Education, and honorary doctorates from Lund and Nancy. Cussler is a Fellow of the American Association for the Advancement of Science and a member of the National Academy of Engineering, joined the University of Minnesota in 1980. He has written over 250 articles and five books, including *Diffusion* and *Chemical Product Design*. Cussler has received the Colburn and Lewis Awards from the
