Bertrand de Montluc is presently associate professor at 'Sciences Po' (I.E.P.) Paris school of higher education and business school specialized in economics and political sciences (Europe-Asia Undergraduate cycle, lecture on Science, Technology & Society). He is a former expert research fellow at the CERI, University of Paris Center for International Relations Studies (international governance of bio and nano-biotechnologies). He acts as president of the strategy and international affairs committee of the non-profit professional organization '3AF' (Aeronautical and Astronautics Association of France). He is a member of the European Academy of Air & Space.

In his previous functions he was Space and Technology senior analyst at the French Foreign Affairs Ministry's Policy planning staff (C.A.P.) and advisor for the director of Strategic affairs (D.A.S.) of the French Ministry of Defense. Before that, for four years he held the position of space & technology counsellor at the Brussels French Diplomatic Delegation to the E.U. (1999-2003). From 1981 to 1999 he worked at the French space agency C.N.E.S. as head of the international relations department, then as deputy director for strategy and european cooperation (ESA and bilateral relations).

Dr de Montluc graduated from the Sciences Po and has a doctorate in law (PHD in international law). He has been honored as 'chevalier' of the National Order of Merit. He is the author of more than 100 publications in the field of space policy, international affairs, defense and security. In 2011, he published a book on the *New Strategic Context of International Space Policies* and in 2013 a book on *Asia and Europe Facing the Technological Revolution* (Nova Publishers, New York, N.J., 2011).
