INTEGRATION ASSESSMENT OF CHINA'S ENERGY EFFICIENCY: INDEX DECOMPOSITION AND FRONTIER APPROACH APPLICATIONS



Jinhe Jiang (female), research fellow of Institute of quantitative and technical economy, Chinese Academy of Social Sciences(CASS), awarded Ph.D. from Peking University in 1999. Now she is engaged in climate change economics, such as, the integrated assessment model(IAM) of the climate change impacts, policy analysis and evaluation of low-carbon economy etc.

By now she has been responsible for or participated in more than 20 projects of research works, which include social science fund project, and National Basic Research Program (973 Programs), and "Twelfth-Five" national technology support program, and commonweal industrial

special fund from the Ministry of Environment Protection, and key projects from CASS, and Sino-UK cooperation research special from MOST, research topics involving national/regional future social economic scenarios development, and China's energy development strategy, and energy efficiency policy and the low carbon development pathways. She has published about 30 academic papers, of which 7 for English papers, 4 English papers into the SCI/SSCI journals.
